## EXTENDED ABSTRACT FORMAT DETAILS

The extended abstract files should consist of:

- Page format should be A4 page size with margins 2.5 cm wide from the right, left, top and bottom.
- 1<sup>st</sup> page: names of authors with affiliation and emails, contact author indication
- Top of the 2<sup>nd</sup> page: short abstract, key words, JEL Codes, after that sections of the extended abstract description
- The font for **short abstract and key words** is Times New Roman, single line spacing and 10 font size, justified
- **Short abstract** should be written with 10 font size, Times New Roman, justified. Objective, method and findings should be summarized in this section. Up to **100 words**
- **JEL Code**s should be listed
- **Key words:** the section should contain **maximum 5 positions** that are written in Times New Roman, 10 font size and seperated with commas
- **Extended abstracts** description should be written according to the structure in the format file and include the **headings**: introduction, methods, findings, and conclusion (Times New Roman, 12 font size, bold, justified)
- The general font for **extended abstract** is Times New Roman, single line spacing and 12 font size. Extended abstracts can contain figures, tables and/or images. **Extended abstracts description should not be shorter than 2 and longer than 3 pages** including the references (so the file should consist of: 1<sup>st</sup> page with author's details and from two to three pages of description, according to the format details)
- Authors names should be given only on the first page. Authors' names must not appear anywhere in the paper starting from the page 2 to 3/4 of the file
- All the tables, images and figures should be centred. Figures and images should be numbered and figure headers should be placed under the figure or image. Tables should be numbered and the table header should be placed at the top. References and notes (<u>if</u> <u>any</u>) of the tables, figures and images should be presented right under the tables, figures and images
- The citation style in the text should be:
  - for **one** author: the surname and year (Toporowski, 2009), or As described by Toporowski (2009)...
  - for **two** authors: names with "and" and the year (Hall and Soskice, 2011), or *As described by Hall and Soskice (2009)...*
  - for three and **more** authors: first author's surname with "et al." and the year (Smith et al. 2009), or *As described by Smith et al. (2009)*...
- References should be numbered and listed in alphabetical order and presented in a format according to the Harvard Style (Times New Roman, single line spacing and 10 font size, according to the detailed format).
